- Format: One page, single spaced, Calibri or Arial 12-pt font, 1" margins, 350 words maximum
- Title of Poster Presentation
- Summary of poster content:

Purpose, Methods, Findings, Conclusions
- Corresponding Author(s)  
Name, affiliation, contact email and phone number

- At least one poster author/presenter must accompany their poster from 5-7:00pm on May 13 and from 8am–2:30pm on May 14.
